1 whole wheat tortilla or large lettuce leaf, 1-2 tbsps hummus or low-fat cream cheese, A variety of colorful vegetables, such as bell peppers, tomatoes, shredded carrots, corn, spinach, cucumbers, lettuce, avocado, shredded cabbage, and etc.

Instructions

1. Lay the **tortilla** or **lettuce leaf** flat on a clean surface.
2. Spread a thin layer of **hummus** or **cream cheese**.
3. Add a small handful of each **colorful vegetable** in rows or layers.
4. Roll up the wrap tightly.
5. Slice in half and enjoy!
