Havasupai Elementary School Compliance Update Report

Overview

This report provides an update on Havasupai Elementary School's (HES) progress towards compliance with the 13 regulations outlined in the Stephen C. Settlement Agreement. Our goal is to ensure that all students receive a high-quality education in a safe and supportive environment.

Key Progress Highlights

1. Updated Work Plan:

- The updated written work plan was posted to the website on June 27, 2025, and can be viewed at the website at the bottom of this document.

2. Teacher Retention Plan:

- A comprehensive teacher retention plan is a current priority, focusing on onboarding and staff support.
- A calendar of retention events is being drafted to enhance staff support.

3. Community Connections Event:

- The community connections event on September 12th, led by facilitators, will support compliance with multiple regulations and aid in staff retention.

4. Library Compliance Efforts:

- Collaboration is underway to create instructional and service objectives and selection policies for the library.
- Exploring virtual options for library book access.
- The team is currently looking at solutions for the inventory and setup of the library.

5. Instructional Progress

- The school is in the process of adopting Schoology as a learning management system. This will support monitoring instructional plans and activities to provide support and ensure adherence to regulations.
- The school has adopted several new curricula and educational programs, including the following: Lego STEAM Education, Fitnessgram, SPARK PE, Character Strong, Core Art Studio, iReady, and SAVVAS for ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

Upcoming Important Dates

- **September 10-12, 2025:** Compliance review visit
- **September 12, 2025:** Community Connections Event
- **October 8, 2025:** Posting of the next updated written work plan online

Monitoring and Support

- **Regular Monitoring:**
 - The Compliance Specialist will conduct regular site visits and reviews to ensure compliance measures are implemented effectively.
