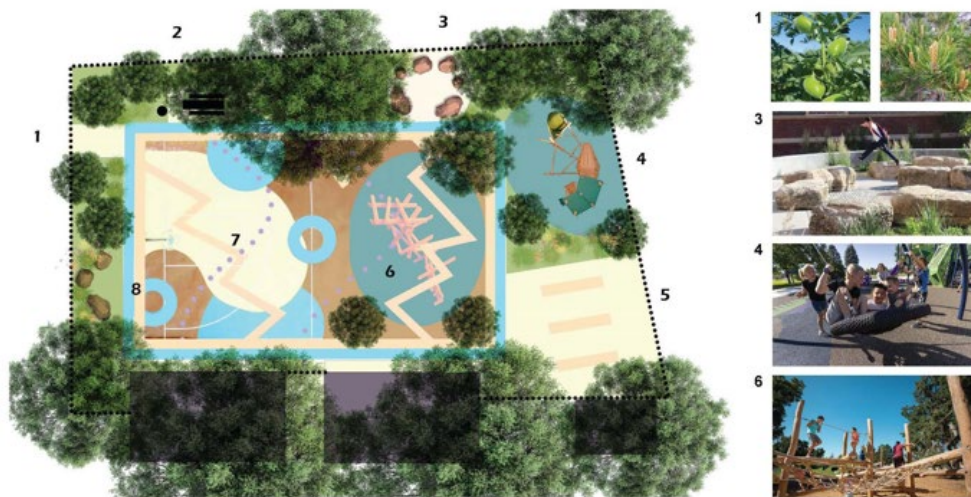
All participating youth will learn from a team led by professional theater artists Larissa FastHorse (Sicangu Lakota) and Michael John Garcés through a series of workshops each day!

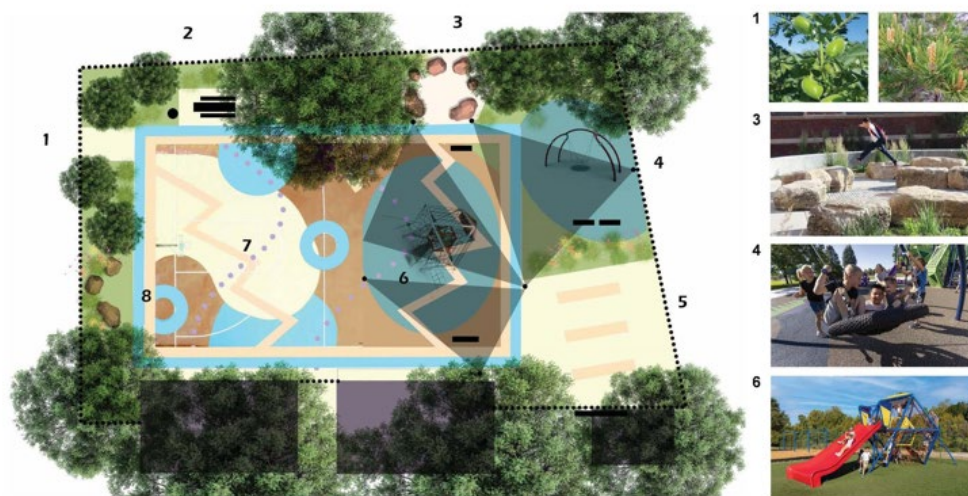
