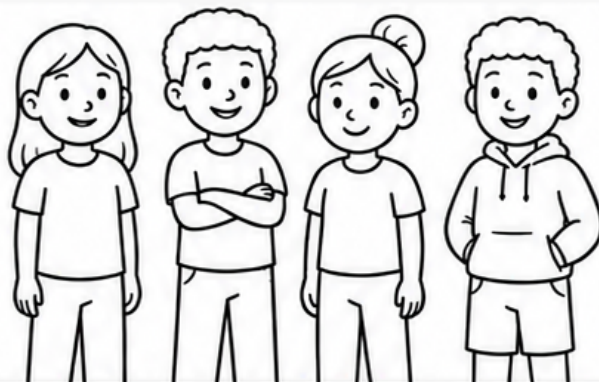

Our Commitment to Families

Havasupai Elementary School believes that children learn best when the school and families work together. We honor Havasupai culture, language, and traditions and welcome every family as a partner in their child's education.

1. Working Together on School Decisions

Families can take part in school planning and decision-making through:

- Monthly School Board meetings
- Textbook Review Committee
- Giving input on new or updated school policies

We will share meeting dates ahead of time and offer flexible meeting options.

2. Open and Respectful Communication

We will communicate with families through phone calls, notes home, community postings, home visits, and tribal communication channels.

We invite families to share questions, concerns, and ideas anytime.

3. Supporting Learning at Home

We will help families support learning by providing:

- Tips for reading, math, and study skills
- Clear expectations for homework and academic progress

4. Family Participation in School Life

Families are encouraged to join us for:

- Family nights and cultural events
- Classroom activities and school celebrations
- Volunteering opportunities whenever possible

5. Supporting Staff to Work With Families

Our staff receives training on family engagement, cultural awareness, and Havasupai history and traditions so they can build strong, respectful relationships.

We work to make participation easier by offering:

- Flexible meeting times
- In person or virtual meetings
